GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

All riders must have an Alberta Equestrian Federation membership.

The judge's decision is final.

Appropriate dress is strongly encouraged. (hat/helmet, long sleeves, jeans/breeches, and riding boots are mandatory)

All juniors (under 18) must wear an approved helmet in both english and western events.

Cleaning up after you and your horse is greatly appreciated and encouraged.

Dogs must be on a leash at all times.

Horse abuse will not be tolerated.

Unruly horses will be excused from the premises.

Exhibitors must be ready and prepared for their class with assigned number.

AGE CATEGORIES (Age as of January 1, 2010)

Senior – Ages 18 and up

Junior A – Ages 14 - 17

Junior B – Ages 11 – 13

Junior C – Ages 10 and under

Open – All participants

ENTRIES

Entry forms and show fees must be received on or before the closing date which is the Friday one week prior to show date.

Waiver forms must be signed.

Post entry fee of \$20.00 / horse will be added to existing fees after closing date.

STABLING

Stabling will be available on a first come, first served basis.

Sage Hill Stable has limited indoor stalls as well as outdoor panel stalls will be set up for the show.

Stall Fees are \$30 for the weekend. First straw bale is provided. Must bring your own feed.

CAMPING

Camping is available. Limited power hook-ups for \$30.00 for the weekend.

Bathroom and shower facilities are available.

PRIZES AND YEAR END AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place.

Prize money is as follows: 1st - \$10.00, 2nd - \$8.00, 3rd - 6.00, 4th - \$4.00, 5th - \$2.00

Stake Classes are based on a percentage pay-out of all stake entries.
